

# COVENANTS PART 1

## Topics Discussed

### 1. Covenant, Old covenant, New covenant, Jews

Carl introduces a series on the covenants, comparing and contrasting the old and new covenant. They discuss the story of the Exodus and the covenant at Mount Sinai, emphasizing that the law was not meant to be permanent and was specifically for the Jewish people. They mention that the covenant is conditional and can be broken. Carl concludes by mentioning that the next session will discuss the division of the law and the new covenant.
