Study Questions

- The term righteousness means “right standing.’ How does this biblical definition change how I see my standing before God? _____

- Examine Second Corinthians 5:21 to see the “divine exchange.”

- Discuss the Old Testament references in Leviticus 1 and 4 regarding the burnt offering and the sin offering. Can we see the “shadow of Christ” in these offerings as it relates to 2 Cor 5:21

- Challenge the belief that right standing with God is based on works and emphasize righteousness obtained through faith. Romans 9:30-31

- Will believing that we have and continue to right standing before God, in Christ, create greater intimacy with Jesus? If so, how?

- **Consider how the Bible ties sin to righteousness. When we have a sin problem, we have a faith or heart problem that is solved in large part by believing we have this right standing. How do we activate it? The same way Jesus took my sin, he received it!**
